Fabric Requirements:

2/3 yard of 45" width

1/3-yard (+1" to be safe) of 45" lining fabric

Optional: piece of black / darker solid or canvas for bottom of tote

1 ¼ yards of woven interfacing of 20" width, or 1 yard of 45" width such as SF101

Additional Supplies:

33" of #5 zipper tape

2- Zipper pulls

1/3 yd of Mesh fabric such as By Annie

2 - 9" All Purpose Zippers

9.5" of ¾" – 1" Fold over Elastic

1" or 1.5" width Hardware (whatever you prefer)

2 – D-Rings or Triangle Rings

2 –Swivel hooks

1 – Tri-glide/slider

64" of Webbing – Either 1 inch or 1 ½ inch can be used but make sure the hardware matches the width of the webbing. The sample is a red webbing.

Sterilite Small 5 Drawer Unit (Available through the store. When you call the store to register for the class, ask to have one held for you, we will hold your 5 drawer unit until the day of class)

General Supplies:

Thread to match all fabrics
Wonder Clips
Straight Pins
Scissors
Stiletto
Seam ripper
Chalk or Fabric Marker
Rotary Cutter and Mat (some are available on-site)
Rulers
Iron and Pressing Mat optional (some are available on-site)
Sewing needles Universal 90/14 or Denim 90/14
Double sided basting tape
Pen, pencil and paper for making notes

Pre-Work:

This pattern must be purchased from the website (not available in paper form)

Print the pattern off. Each customer must purchase the pattern, please do not make copies to share with your friends.

On page 3 of the pattern is a great check off list for cutting pieces. All the pieces are fused with interfacing (SF 101) but 4. These 4 pieces are listed in the “Lining” in the checklist. Check out the “Tips & Hints” beside the check list. The pattern suggests cutting these 4 pieces first, then fusing the rest of the fabric with the interfacing, then finish cutting the remaining pieces. By pre- fusing the fabric you will save time and you will not have to cut the interfacing again. **Be sure to label all the pieces with the name and the measurements.**

In class we will start on page 4 with “Add tabs to the zippers”

The front panel of the bag can be embroidered, or a small panel can be used, or fussy cut a design. If you have a cutting machine such as a “Cut & Scan” you can add a design or name using vinyl.
