Fabric Requirements

Jelly roll or 17 strips of fabric cut 2 ½ inches X WOF

2 fat quarters or ½ yard for the lining

Notions/Embellishments/Notions

1 yard heavy weight fusible interfacing such as Décor Bond 809 or Pellon Craft Fuse

1/2 yard light weight fusible interfacing such as SF101

4 Buttons about ¾ inch or a little larger, if using covered buttons you will need a covered button kit

Foam core board, cardboard, or 2 pieces peltex sew together cut 5 inches by 15 inches for the bag bottom

Thread to match

Sewing Machine

Bring your own machine or rent one from the shop (reserve when registering for the class).

Bring power cord, foot pedal, and manual (you never know!), if using your own machine

Required Feet/Hoops/Accessories/Needles(Extra needles are not included with Machine Rental)

Universal 90/14 or 80/12 needles

Open toed sewing foot

Quarter inch foot

General Sewing Supplies(Not included with Machine Rental)

Straight Pin

Wonder Clips

Scissors/Snippers and Seam Ripper

Turning Tool

Marking Tools (Water Soluble Fabric Marker, Pencil, Pen, Chalk)

Iron and Pressing Mat (optional – some available on site)

Extra Sewing Machine Needles

Hand sewing needle (to sew on buttons)

Misc. Items

Pen, pencil and paper for making notes

Sack Lunch and Drink

Pre-Class Instructions

Bring a jelly roll or cut 17 strips of fabric cut 2 ½ inches X WOF

- 8 strips will be used for the outside
- 1 strip will be used for the covered buttons
- 3 strips will be used for the pockets inside the bag
- 1 strip will be used binding
- 4 strips will be used for handles

Cut 2 lining pieces and 2 pieces of heavyweight fusible interfacing 20 inches by 16 ½ inches

This is a fun and easy tote! From one jelly roll you can get 2 to 3 totes. So make one for yourself and one for a friend! You can use any fabric!
