Fabric Requirements - This is enough to make all nine blocks

9 Coordinating Fat Quarters or 9 - $\frac{3}{8}$ yard cuts - Use solids or tonal fabrics so stitches and embellishments show up.

1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yd. muslin or white/off white cotton fabric for individual block backs

$\frac{1}{3}$ yd. cotton fabric for sashing

1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yd. Cotton fabric for quilt back and binding

Notions/Embellishments

10 Decorative Buttons, $\frac{1}{2}$ - $\frac{3}{4}$ " Wide

Sewing Machine

Bring your own machine or rent one from the shop (reserve when registering for the class).

Bring your power cord, foot control and machine manual (you never know!) if using your own machine. All machines are welcome, from basic to top-of-the-line.

Required Feet/Hoops/Accessories/Needles

NOTE: BERNINA foot names & numbers are listed. If you have another brand of machine, bring the equivalent accessory feet that go with your machine.

For all blocks:

Open toe foot for sewing decorative stitches (BERNINA foot 20/20C/20D)

Edgestitch Foot (BERNINA foot 10/10C/10D)

Patchwork Foot (BERNINA foot 37/57/97)

80/12 Microtex needles

505 Temporary Adhesive Spray

BERNINA Big Book of Feet - Optional but VERY helpful!

BERNINA Big Book of Stitches - Also Optional but also VERY Helpful

For the June Block:

Three-Groove Pintuck Foot #31

Walking Foot #50

Button Sew-On Foot #18

2.0/80 Twin Needle

Variegated Embroidery Thread (Optional, but looks cool!)

Specialty Rulers

18 - 24" Quilting Ruler.

Thread

Sewing thread to match fabric

Machine embroidery thread; polyester or rayon in assorted colors to coordinate with fabric

12 Weight Spaghetti or Fruit thread to match fabric

Stabilizer, Interfacing, Batting - This is enough to make all nine blocks.

Pellon Featherweight Non-woven Interfacing #910: 3 Yards (20"Wide)

Quilter's Dream Cotton Batting: Crib size, 46" x 60"

Rotary Cutting Supplies

Cutter and Mat

Rulers

General Sewing Supplies

Straight Pins, Wonder Clips

Scissors/Snippers and Seam Ripper

Turning Tool

Marking Tools (Water Soluble Fabric Marker, Pencil, Pen, Chalk)

Iron and Pressing Mat (optional - some available on site)

Extra Sewing Machine Needles

Seam gauge

Pre-Class Instructions

Before Class: Please purchase your fabric, interfacing and batting before class. The fabric requirements listed are enough to make the entire quilt.

The interfacing used in the project, Pellon Featherweight Non-Woven #910 is used because of it's crisp consistency, making it ideal for marking the block sections.

- Cut one 12" square each of interfacing, batting and muslin.
- Spray baste the three layers together in this order: interfacing, batting, muslin.

Fabric, supplies and BERNINA accessories are available for purchase at Chestnut Ridge Sewing.
